

Code of Conduct for Drivers on Nine Mile Beach

Rules and regulations governing vehicle access and driving on Nine Mile Beach

1. Access to BWSP and Nine Mile beach is at your own risk.
2. **4WD road registered vehicle access only. It is mandatory to display valid beach permit fixed to windscreen.**
3. No motorbikes, quad bikes, trikes, ATVs, 2WD vehicles or non-road registered motor vehicles permitted.
4. Enter and exit at designated access points only: *Kalaroo Road, Jewells, Beach Street/Ocean Park Road, Belmont South and Awabakal Ave, Blacksmiths.*
5. **NSW road rules apply:** 1) Seat belts must be worn 2) Vehicles must be registered 3) Drivers must be licensed 4) Do not drive under the influence of alcohol or other drugs
6. Speed limits are enforceable 30kph unless within 30m of pedestrians. Pedestrians have the right of way always. 15kph within 30m of pedestrians.
7. Vehicles should not be parked within 20m of access points to the beach or along the beach access tracks.
8. **No driving or parking on vegetation or restricted areas, e.g. sand dunes.**
9. Vehicles should only drive on the designated beach area and not stray onto LMCC land. (See map: S. of Awabakal Ave entry or N. of Third Creek-no access)
10. Beach Permit can only be used on the nominated 4WD vehicle and is not transferable to any other 4WD vehicle.
11. Keep the environment clean. Take out what you bring in. Fines apply for littering offences.
12. **Report damage to Park infrastructure and unlawful behaviour to *Police Assistance Line on 131444, or Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000***

Further Guidelines:

13. BWSP LMB reserves the right to close access to the beach in the event of a natural disaster, heavy seas, or if considered essential by BWSP Land Manager Board.
14. **Reduce tyre pressures to 12 psi.** Carry water, mobiles, recovery gear, snatch straps, bow shackles and shovel.
15. ***This beach permit may only be replaced if it is damaged or your vehicle is sold.***
